Quorum being present, the Mayor continued with the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to hear from the public, approve the consent agenda minutes, voucher list and accept the financial report, hear reports from the departments, review and approve personnel action requests to accept the resignation of Police Officer Terrell George and approve Mark Nichols as Full-Time Police Officer with the standard probationary period, review and approve Resolution 20-009 Resolution expressing enduring gratitude and appreciation to the volunteers who contributed their time, energy and funds to assist with immediate needs after the April 22, 2020, tornado, review and approve Resolution 20-010 authorizing Raymond K. Vann & Associates to provide Administrative services for the 2020 Texas

Community Development Block Grant – FAST, review and approve request for variance by Kickapoo Bait & Tackle and announce any other upcoming events.

REPORTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT

Police Department reported that the department traveled 5414 miles during February 2020; responded to 1246 non-dispatched calls; 195 dispatched calls; 17 officer assists, and assisted the fire department 3 times. Besides all of this, 141 citations, 59 warnings. Worked 54 cases, 33 misdemeanor arrests and 5 felony arrest were made.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Department reported that the Fire Department responded to 28 calls for assistance during February 2020. 19 medical calls, 1 structure fire, 1 grass fire, 0 vehicle fires, 0 motor vehicle accidents, 0 lake rescues, 2 landing zones, 0 hazmat calls, 4 assist calls and 1 mutual-aide call, totaling 34 volunteer man hours.

CODE ENFORCEMENT/PERMITING

<u>Building Inspector</u>- During February 2020, 16 permits were issued. Total permit fees collected were **\$4259**. The total added value to the city was **\$334,557**.

<u>Code Enforcement</u> – During February 2020 there were 7 warrants issued on repeat offenders. One property brought into compliance with a total of 10 cases worked.

<u>Fire Investigations –</u> There was no fire investigations in February.
