REPORTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT

Police Department reported that the department traveled 4257 miles during May 2023; 412 Subdivision Patrols, 88 Business Checks, 399 Calls for Service, 34 Arrests, 74 Citations, 81 Warnings, Other Agency Assist 5 times and Assisted OVFD/EMS 8 times, 24 Cases and 22 Warrants served.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Department reported that the Fire Department responded to 64 calls for assistance during May 2023. 44 medical calls, 3 structure fires, 3 grass fires, 1 vehicle fire, 4 motor vehicle accidents, 3 lake rescues, 2 landing zone calls, 0 hazmat calls, 3 assist calls and 1 mutual-aide call, totaling 99 volunteer man hours.

CODE ENFORCEMENT/PERMITING

There were 16 permits issued and 7 inspections performed in the month of May. Total collected was \$5591.70. Also, Multiple enforcements were started and are in various stages such as warnings, citations, up to Court Summons. Most properties had several violations.

FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

Currently 1 ongoing investigation awaiting results from forensic lab.
