Quorum being present, T. D. Jennings and Ronald Gilbert absence was excused, the Mayor continued with the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to hear from the public, approve the consent agenda minutes, voucher list and accept the financial report, hear reports from the departments, Review and approve the hiring of Adam Williford, Police Officer Labor Pool, review and approve Ordinance 440 Governing Cabin Parks, review and approve Ordinance 441 Animal Control, review and approve Ordinance 442 Wrecking and Salvage Yards, Executive Session in accordance with 551.074 Personnel Matters - Civil Action No. 9:12cv67 and announce any other upcoming events.

#### **CONSENT AGENDA**

### **REPORTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Police Department reported that the department traveled 3455.7 miles during June 2023; 358 Subdivision Patrols, 100 Business Checks, 418 Calls for Service, 8 Arrests, 80 Citations, 153 Warnings, Other Agency Assist 8 times and Assisted OVFD/EMS 9 times, 22 Cases and 10 Warrants served.

### **FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Fire Department reported that the Fire Department responded to 57 calls for assistance during June 2023. 29 medical calls, 3 structure fires, 3 grass fires, 0 vehicle fires, 5 motor vehicle accidents, 2 lake rescues, 9 landing zone calls, 0 hazmat calls, 4 assist calls and 2 mutual-aide calls, totaling 147 volunteer man hours.

## **CODE ENFORCEMENT/PERMITING**

There were 18 permits issued and 7 inspections performed in the month of June. Total collected was \$5910.00. Also, Multiple enforcements were started and are in various stages such as warnings, citations, up to Court Summons. Most properties had several violations.

#### **FIRE INVESTIGATIONS**

There was one fire incident from May that the investigation carried over to June that has been finalized with 3 Felony Warrants issued.
