Quorum being present, Ronald Gilbert absent, the Mayor continued with the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to hear from the public, approve the consent agenda minutes, voucher list and accept the financial report, hear reports from the departments, discuss recruitment options presented with possible action to authorize the creation of Resolution 2023-0023 specifying approved tactics and setting an effective date and announce any other upcoming events.

PLEDGE & PRAYER

Louis Fresquez, opened the meeting with a prayer and Mayor James W. Arnett led the pledge to the American and Texas Flags.

PUBLIC FORUM

Louis Fresquez introduced the program Celebrate Recovery currently hosted at Revival Center Church which is designed to help bring sustainable recovery and healing to our hurts. It guides toward new healthy truths and life-giving habits. This program can serve as an alternative to AA.

CONSENT AGENDA

It was moved by Shirley Gilmore and a second was made by Kevin Arnett to accept and approve items listed on the consent agenda as presented.

REPORTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT

Police Department reported that the department traveled 3425.4 miles during September 2023; 415 Subdivision Patrols, 70 Business Checks, 412 Calls for Service, 44 Arrests, 31 Citations, 26 Warnings, Other Agency Assist 28 times and Assisted OVFD/EMS 7 times, 34 Cases and 30 Warrants served.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Department reported that the Fire Department responded to 54 calls for assistance during September 2023. 30 medical calls, 1 structure fire, 6 grass fires, 2 vehicle fires, 2 motor vehicle accidents, 0 lake rescues, 3 landing zone calls, 0 hazmat calls, 2 assist calls and 8 mutual-aide calls, totaling 193 volunteer man hours.

CODE ENFORCEMENT/PERMITING

There were 22 permits issued and 3 code enforcement cases pending in various stages for the month of September. Total collected was \$5,391.00.

FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

There were no fire investigations in September.
