Quorum being present, the Mayor Pro Tem continued with the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to hear from the public, approve the consent agenda minutes, voucher list and accept the financial report, hear reports from the departments, presentation by Dennis E. Horn or representative regarding property located at 312 Moose Dr., Onalaska, Texas and being located in the Impala Woods Section 1, Block 8 lots 3, 4, and 5 described in a deed dated October 17, 2001 from Kevin and Lisa Jewell to Dennis Horn recorded in Volume 1225, Page 728 of the Official Public Records of Polk County, Texas to show cause why such building should not be declared unsafe and/or dangerous, action to declare building dangerous or unsafe as determined by City Council regarding property owned by, Dennis E. Horn or representative located at 312 Moose Dr., Onalaska, Texas and being located in the Impala Woods Section 1, Block 8 lots 3, 4, and 5 described in a deed dated October 17, 2001 from Kevin and Lisa Jewell to Dennis Horn recorded in Volume 1225, Page 728 of the Official Public Records of Polk County, Texas and order to vacate, remove or demolish said structure, motion to approve \$2000 for the purchase of a used trailer necessary to transport and store the barge, motion to approve materials to be ordered for repairs to Magnolia Ridge, estimated cost not to exceed \$5,000 and announce any other upcoming events.

REPORTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT

Police Department reported that the department traveled 3855 miles during March 2022; 317 Subdivision Patrols, 115 Business Checks, 406 Calls for Service, 10 Felony Arrests, 8 Misdemeanor Arrests, 158 Citations, 192 Warnings, Assisted PCSO 18 times, Assisted DPS 0 times and Assisted OVFD/EMS 22 times, 40 Cases, 5 Narcotic/DWI Arrest and worked on 3 warrants worked.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Department reported that the Fire Department responded to 50 calls for assistance during March 2022. 19 medical calls, 4 structure fires, 8 grass fires, 2 vehicle fires, 4 motor vehicle accidents, 2 lake rescues, 5 landing zone calls, 0 hazmat calls, 4 assist calls and 6 mutual-aide calls, totaling 147 volunteer man hours.

CITY ADMINISTRATOR REPORT ON STREET REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE

Holmes Road project complete, Pine Grove and Sycamore were started by filling the large holes with rock to push out the water. The road must dry out prior to adding materials to create a proper base.

Magnolia Ridge continues to request assistance with road repairs. Road is approximately 450' and requires additional materials and bladework. Residents advise they are at times unable to get into their own driveways. I am requesting council consider action item below.

We are seeking volunteer assistance to clean up and around the city sidewalks.
