Quorum being present, JR Chance's absence was excused, the Mayor continued with the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to hear from the public, approve the consent agenda minutes, voucher list and accept the financial report, hear reports from the departments, review, approve and replace Police Department policy 6.0 Dress Code, review and approve Ordinance No. 410 Alarm Ordinance, review and approve Ordinance No. 411 Residential Lawn Minimum Standards and announce any other upcoming events.

#### **CONSENT AGENDA**

#### **REPORTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Police Department reported that the department traveled 3698 miles during June 2021; 313 Subdivision Patrols, 40 Business Checks, 325 Calls for Service, 3 Felony Arrests, 10 Misdemeanor Arrests, 79 Citations, 70 Warnings, Assisted PCSO 17 times, Assisted DPS 3 times and Assisted OVFD/EMS 6 times, 50 New Cases, 2 Narcotic/DWI Arrests and 83 Warrants Cleared.

#### **FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Fire Department reported that the Fire Department responded to 29 calls for assistance during June 2021. 23 medical calls, 1 structure fire, 0 grass fires, 0 vehicle fires, 3 motor vehicle accidents, 0 lake rescues, 0 landing zone calls, 0 hazmat calls, 3 assist calls and 1 mutual-aide call, totaling 50 volunteer man hours.

#### **CODE ENFORCEMENT/PERMITING**

**<u>Building Inspector</u>**- During June 2021, 21 permits were issued. Total permit fees collected were **\$13,271.92** The total added value to the city was **\$953,129.92**.

<u>Code Enforcement</u> – There were a total of 7 warnings issued. There was also an arrest made back in May for a Class A Misdemeanor for Illegal Dumping. This arrest clear 49 Municipal Court Warrants that were Class C charges ranging from Unsanitary/Unwholesome Conditions, Dogs at Large, No Proof of Vaccination, Livestock at Large (pig), There are two homes that were condemned that we are awaiting the ground to get dry enough for large equipment so a demolition abatement can be performed. One is located in Twin Harbors and the other has two structures on in located in Impala Woods. Abatement cost will be invoiced to the property owner(s) with a lien placed on the property.

<u>Fire Investigations</u> – There is one ongoing fire investigation within the city. Annual Fire Code Compliance inspections will be done in the month of July.
