Quorum being present, the Mayor continued with the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to hear from the public, approve the consent agenda minutes, voucher list and accept the financial report, hear reports from the departments, review and approve personnel action requests, review and consider Resolution 20-013 a Resolution to apply for 2020 TxCDBG-FAST (Fire, Ambulance, and Service Truck) funding, review and consider variance request by Katherine Presnell and announce any other upcoming events.

REPORTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT

Police Department reported that the department traveled 5476 miles during July 2020; responded to 1391 non-dispatched calls; 279 dispatched calls; 23 officer assists, and assisted the fire department 5 times. Besides all of this, 89 citations, 41 warnings. Opened 63 new cases, 8 misdemeanor arrests and 8 felony arrest were made.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Department reported that the Fire Department responded to 37 calls for assistance during July 2020. 22 medical calls, 2 structure fires, 1 grass fire, 0 vehicle fires, 2 motor vehicle accidents, 4 lake rescues, 3 landing zones, 1 hazmat call, 1 assist call and 1 mutual-aide call, totaling 62 volunteer man hours.

CODE ENFORCEMENT/PERMITING

<u>Building Inspector</u>- During July 2020, 20 permits were issued. Total permit fees collected were **\$3097** The total added value to the city was **\$428,800**.

<u>Code Enforcement</u> – Continue to monitor and assisting with post tornado clean-up efforts. There were 17 contacts for various City Ordinance violations for unwholesome conditions and Animal Ordinance violations.

<u>Fire Investigations</u> – There were two fire investigations in July that are still ongoing. One of which has charges pending completion of the investigation.
