Quorum being present, James Arnett's absence was excused, the Mayor continued with the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to hear from the public, approve the consent agenda minutes, voucher list and accept the financial report, hear reports from the departments, review and approve personnel action requests, review and approve Resolution 19-011 to approve the purchase of a 2020 Pierce Commercial Freightliner Pumper for the Onalaska Volunteer Fire Department, review and approve final plat submission for the Autumn Trails Subdivision Section Two dated October 2019 and announce any other upcoming events.

#### **PLEDGE & PRAYER**

Pastor Cameron Veasey opened the meeting with a prayer and Onalaska JROTC Sgt. 1<sup>st</sup> Class Dustin Owens led the pledge to the American and Texas Flags.

#### **CONSENT AGENDA**

#### **REPORTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Police Department reported that the department traveled 5775 miles during September 2019; responded to 1360 non-dispatched calls; 321 dispatched calls; 19 officer assists, and assisted the fire department 3 times. Besides all of this, 191 citations, 52 warnings. Worked 40 cases, 23 misdemeanor arrests and 11 felony arrest were made.

#### **FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Fire Department reported that the Fire Department responded to 33 calls for assistance during September 2019. 23 medical calls, 1 structure fire, 4 grass fire, 0 vehicle fires, 0 motor vehicle accidents, 0 lake rescues, 1 landing zone, 0 hazmat calls, 0 assist calls and 2 mutual-aide calls, totaling 37 volunteer man hours.

#### **CODE ENFORCEMENT/PERMITING**

**<u>Building Inspector</u>**- During the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, 283 permits were issued. Total permit fees collected were **\$22,591.00**. The total added value to the city was **\$2,804,938.00**.

<u>Code Enforcement</u> – During the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019 there were 267 citations and 46 warnings issued for Ordinance Violations. Total cases worked for the year were 294.

<u>Fire Investigations</u> – There were 4 fire investigations in fiscal year ending September 30, 2019.

#### LIBRARY BOARD REPORT

Librarian reported the Library Board is reviewing the five-year plan to make certain the library is prioritizing the most needed services with little clerical help at this time. We want to be as efficient as possible while still moving in the right direction.

Steve Eckert accepted the designation of Volunteer Coordinator. Already a Library Board Representative, Steve will head-up recruitment and training for these much needed Library Assistant positions.

Books checked out: 712; Patrons: 1137; Computer Usage: 147; Copies/Faxes \$294.25; Fines: \$18.45; Membership Fee: \$0.00; Postage: \$3.00; Book Replacement: \$0.00; Proctoring \$0.00; Auxiliary Fund \$129.00; Restricted Donations: \$0.00 and Regular Donations: \$204.40 and 32.3 Volunteer Hours were documented.
