Quorum being present, James Arnett's absence was excused, the Mayor continued with the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to hear from the public, approve the consent agenda minutes, voucher list and accept the financial report, hear reports from the departments, review and approve personnel action requests - approve Simon Prince to serve as Full-Time Police Officer with the standard probationary period, Canvass November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020, General City Election, approve Resolution 20-015 declaring the results of said election, administer statements of elected officer's, oaths of office and election certificates to elected officials, elect Mayor Pro-Tem, review and approve Resolution 20-016 designating signatories for all city bank accounts, re-appoint David Johnson as Municipal Judge, administer statement of elected/appointed officer and oath of office, re-appoint Associate Municipal Judge Greg Magee, administer statement of elected/appointed officer and oath of office, accept resignation of David Moorman City Prosecutor/City Attorney, appoint Chris Thompson as City Prosecutor/City Attorney, approve Ordinance 402 an ordinance affecting participation of city employees in the Texas Municipal

# **REPORTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Police Department reported that the department traveled 4077 miles during October 2020; responded to 1241 non-dispatched calls; 424 dispatched calls; 20 officer assists, and assisted the fire department 18 times. Besides all of this, 98 citations, 56 warnings. Opened 82 new cases, 8 misdemeanor arrests and 10 felony arrest were made.

#### **FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Fire Department reported that the Fire Department responded to 25 calls for assistance during October 2020. 11 medical calls, 2 structure fires, 5 grass fires, 0 vehicle fires, 2 motor vehicle accidents, 1 lake rescue, 1 landing zone, 0 hazmat calls, 3 assist calls and 0 mutual-aide calls, totaling 82 volunteer man hours.

## **CODE ENFORCEMENT/PERMITING**

Building Inspector - During October 2020, 20 permits were issued. Total permit fees collected were \$4284.90 The total added value to the city was \$655,650.

Code Enforcement - There were 26 citations and 16 warnings issued for various City Ordinance

<u>Fire Investigations</u> - There were two fire investigations in October. One is still under investigation.
